

Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster Summary of Activity in Academic Year 2024-25

The Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster is made up of 21 schools.
The Music Cluster Coordinator is Steph Farr

Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster in numbers (September 2024 to July 2025):

- **15** of the schools engaged regularly in the music cluster
- **2** of the schools received a Music Challenge and Support visit from the Cluster Coordinator.
- Staff from **9** of the schools attended Music Cluster Meetings.
- Pupils from **12** of the schools participated in a Cluster Project.
- Staff from **9** of the schools attended CPD provided by GSW Music Hub, Swindon & Wiltshire.
- **13** of the schools had GSW Music Hub Swindon & Wiltshire Associates providing instrumental and vocal tuition.
- **26** Associate from GSW Music Hub, Swindon & Wiltshire, provided tuition in this school cluster.
- **6** schools accessed a reduced price Charanga licence through GSW Music Hub, Swindon & Wiltshire.
- **3** schools received a grant through GSW Music Hub, Swindon & Wiltshire's School Development Fund.
- **3** schools received a free Singing Leader visit.
- **5** schools received a subsidised music performance funded by GSW Music Hub Swindon & Wiltshire.
- **0** schools received free STEAM workshops from Conductive Music.
- **11** schools received either First Access, Tuition or Progression Bursary

GSW Music Hub Swindon & Wiltshire invested a total of £10,682.80 in Marlborough & Pewsey Music Cluster during January to July 2025. This included:

- **£3,940.93** for cluster co-ordination, project activity and CPD for cluster members.
- **£1,709.04** on subsidising First Access (WCET) provision costs in the cluster schools
- **£3,620.28** for instrumental and vocal tuition bursaries for disadvantaged learners in the cluster schools.
- **£1,412.55** in grants for school music development.
